PREDICTING COVID: YOUNG, NATURE, FUTURE, FEARS.

One of the experiences which contributed to the observation and the collection of helpful elements in fueling the research on the "contemporary fears" promoted by Ariele Associazione Italiana di Psicosocioanalisi Polis Group regards an interview conducted in the Spring of 2019 addressed to twelve-grade teenagers from a scientific High School in a semi-suburban neighbourhood in Milan, using the pshycosocioanalytical group interview, focused on the contents, on the processes and on the emerging psychic instances.

The purpose of this workshop is to share and discuss how the words of the boys and girls were a prediction of the pandemia: mourning vision of the future, fear of death and loss, loneliness and isolation, poverty, anxiety of failure.

Are they predicting Covid-19 vulnerability and powerlesness of us all?

In this workshop we are going to discuss about fears and future of the young generation and to explore the role of Institutions to face the Covid-19 pandemic period, with an innovative approach.
